

Longwood Wins Grout Invitational

Three Long Island schools finished in the top four places of the Grout Invitational Division I category yesterday at Memorial Park in Schenectady. Longwood beat Niskayuna, 33-59, to win the team championship, Whitman (80) finished third and Bayport (110) was fourth. Longwood's Kevin Hogan (13:14) and Danny Mallon (13:46) finished first and second as five Lions placed in the top 15 in the 2.6-mile race.

In Division III, Northport placed second with 101 points as Keith Benishine took fourth and Dan Sherry (9:30.1) won the freshman race. Mattituck's Rob Levy (13:52) was third in the Class C race . . . Rocky Point's Lori Smith (16:33) placed third in the girls race.

St. Anthony's won the University of Virginia Invitational, beating Arroyo (Grande, Calif.), 155-188. Three Friars finished in the top 20 of a race that featured more than 301 runners from four

states. Mark Naso (16:25) was fourth.

St. Anthony's girls scored 74 points to finish second in the Nazareth Invitational at Van Cortlandt Park. Notre Dame Academy of Staten Island won the event with 35 points. St. Anthony's Kaci Holt (17:11) was eighth and Jeane Dougherty (17:15) was ninth.
